Where should I park?

Staff and visitors will be encouraged to park south and east of the Chancery or in the Lord's Diner parking lot on weekdays. The parking lot on the southwest corner of Central and Broadway will be available on weekends. A limited number of handicap accessible parking spaces will be available south of the church while Masses are still celebrated in the church.
